## Clinton Chamber of Commerce Networking Breakfast at The Clinton Pool Tuesday, July 12 from 8 - 9:30 am



The pool opens every summer in mid-June to provide swimming, lessons, and other programming for children and families. In recent years, other activities, including arts and crafts, food trucks, parties, outdoor movie nights, birthday parties, and more. Attendance last summer was over 6,300 bathers: best summer ever! The pool has become a valuable community resource for the residents of Clinton and the surrounding area.

The CYF is supported by a grant from the Community Foundation as well as donations from the Town of Kirkland
