

The chairs are rotated around the village at the various sponsor locations, and bids are accepted and updated on the Clinton Chamber of Commerce website (www.clintonnychamber.org). New this year, five Adirondack garden benches were added to the 18 rockers, for a total of 23 items up for auction.

Art Rocks concludes with a Live Auction scheduled for September 7th at 7:00pm on the Village Green. Everyone is invited to attend the live auction and take part in the excitement. If you are not able to attend the Live Auction, you can place a Reserve Bid, which will allow the Clinton Chamber to bid on your behalf at the Live Auction, at a limit you set.


