Art Rocks is a fundraiser for the Clinton Chamber that is an art auction pairing local artists and businesses. We then create an outdoor gallery of hand painted, custom-designed Adirondack rocking chairs throughout Clinton. The Clinton Chamber Member sponsors display the chair at their business for the summer months. The chairs are rotated around the village at the various sponsor locations, and bids are accepted and updated on the Clinton Chamber of Commerce website (https://clintonnvchamber.org/art-rocks). This year we are adding a limited number of 3/4 scale children's rockers to the program!

Art Rocks typically concludes with a Live Auction, however this year we are adapting the event to conclude with a Silent Auction. Bids will be accepted on the Clinton Chamber website, and more details about the Silent Auction will be coming soon.

Starting in late June, the Adirondack rockers will be on display throughout the Village of Clinton and beyond. We will map out the "Art Rocks Stroll" so you can take in the complete outdoor gallery.
