

Rise Against Hunger's meal packaging program is a volunteer-based initiative that coordinates the assembly-line packaging of highly nutritious dehydrated meals comprised of rice. soy, vegetables, and 23 essential vitamins and minerals. Rise Against Hunger meals are provided in schools to encourage increased enrollment and attendance. For adults in community empowerment programs. the provision of meals offsets productive time lost while attending training sessions. Meals distributed in hospitals and clinics may support patients' nutritional needs and complement their treatments. For more information about Rise Against Hunger go to

Volunteers will help package up to 45,000 meals on Saturday, October 3rd

- We need about 120 volunteers for 2 shifts: 9am – 11am and 12:00pm - 2:00pm
- Children age 5-14 are welcome, but must be accompanied by an adult
- Families/groups of 3-5 are needed to operate the ingredient filling stations
- Extra precautions will be in place to follow CDC safe guidelines for social gatherings
- All volunteers must register online by October 2 at midnight.
