Village of Clinton - Garbage, Recyclables, Trash, Debris, and Green Waste Pick up Schedule for 2021



Materials Definitions

Household Garbage: Kitchen waste, non-recyclable material, other general waste produced in the home.

Recyclables: Cardboard, paper, plastic, metal and glass as defined by the Oneida-Herkimer Solid Waste Authority www.ohsa.org/enr/cycle

Metal: All types of metal objects, pipes, wire, springs, valves, bikes, water heaters, lawn mowers, appliances, etc. not to exceed 8 feet in length.

General Household Trash: Furniture, rugs, mattresses, large plastics, kid toys, plastic pools, etc.

Construction Debris: Shingles, plaster, sheetrock, lumber.

Automotive Items: Tires and car batteries.

Electronics: Televisions, computers, modems, etc.

Propane Tanks: 20 pound tanks or less.

Hazardous Waste: Paint, chemicals, rechargeable batteries and propane tanks over 20 lbs. as defined by the Oneida-Herkimer Solid Waste Authority www.ohsa.org/enr/cycle

Green Waste: Leaves, compost, vines, bark, tree limbs, Christmas trees and sod.

Clean Hard Fill: Bricks, stone, rocks, landscape pavers and bulk soil not contaminated by fuel, infectious or hazardous waste.

General Information

The Village of Clinton has access to the Green Waste Composting Facility with the Town of Kirkland, which allows DPW to dispose of green waste. Use of this facility requires green waste to be separated by type.

► The Green Waste Composting Facility is located at the Town recycling yard and is available for Village residents to drop off their green waste from April 1 to December 15 between the hours of 8:30 am to 3:30 pm. This requires residents to separate green waste as noted inside this brochure.

► DPW or the Garbage Contractor will not pick up debris generated by contractors performing building renovation or tree removal. Residents need to inform their contractors to make arrangements for debris removal.

► Village residents may take wood chips for home use at no charge at the Town's recycling yard during the hours of 8:30 am to 3:30 pm.

► The Village will publish a pick up schedule at the beginning of each year. The schedule will be available in the Village Office, the Village website and published in the Waterville Times.

The Village of Clinton provides for the pick up of household garbage, recyclables, general household trash, and minor generated construction waste (small, yard (green) waste and yard debris (soil, rocks, bricks/pavers)).

The Village contracts with a commercial hauler to pick up garbage and recyclables. Village employees from the Department of Public Works-DPW pick up all other types of waste. These services are performed as a courtesy to Village residents and for the general welfare. Abuse of this service will be addressed with homeowners.

This policy defines the waste types picked up by the Village and provides a definitive schedule for residents to place their waste on the curb in a timely manner for pickup.

PICK UP <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Weekly on Tuesday in the residential area Tuesdays and Fridays in the Commercial District <p>The Village contracts with a commercial hauler to pick up household garbage and recyclables throughout the year, weekly on Tuesday in the residential area and Tuesdays and Fridays in the Commercial District.</p> <p>PLEASE NOTE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Garbage must be bagged and in containers, weight not to exceed 50 lbs. Recyclables must be loose and in containers; weight not to exceed 50 lbs. In the Commercial District, recyclables are only picked up on Tuesday. Place garbage and recyclables at the curb after 5pm on the day before pick up. 	PICK UP <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Regular pick ups run from April through November Bi-weekly on the first and third Monday and Tuesday <p>DPW will pick up green waste and clean hard fill from April through November. Due to snow removal, green waste and clean hard fill will not be picked up in January, February, March and December.</p> <p>PLEASE NOTE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Loose leaves will be picked up in April, October and November. If PLACED IN PAPER BAGS, loose leaves will be picked up in May, June, July, August and September. Christmas Trees will be picked up in December and January. No grass clippings are allowed. Suggestions: leave grass clippings on lawn (re-mulch) or compost. Compost, soil, sand, and brush (including vines, branches, bark) are green waste. This must be in a pile and not mixed with clean hard fill. For garbage placed in the plastic container must be removed, place dirt in pile and recycle the container. Landfill bricks, stone, rock and dirt will be picked up in piles not mixed with clean hard fill. No green waste can exceed 5 feet in length (multiple piles allowed, each being 10' or less for ease of pick up). Green Waste piles must NEVER be placed on the street or sidewalk (use the space in between). If the piles obstruct the street/sidewalk, the owner may be fined for violation of the Village Street Ordinances. Green Waste may be put out after 5pm the Friday before the scheduled pick up. 	PICK UP <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Regular pick ups run from April through November Monthly on the last Wednesday <p>General Household Trash & Debris, including: Metal, Construction Debris, Automotive Items, Electronics, Large Plastics, Kid Toys, Plastic Pools and 20 lbs. Propane Tanks. DPW will pick up these items once monthly on the last Wednesday from April through November. Due to snow removal, these items will not be picked up in January, February, March and December.</p> <p>PLEASE NOTE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All items must be sorted into separate piles. Non-Contractor/Homeowner Construction Debris must be sorted, piles should not exceed 8 feet in length and 50 lbs. in weight. Place sorted items out after 5pm on the Tuesday evening before pick up on the scheduled Wednesday. Hazardous Waste will not be picked up including paint, chemicals, rechargeable batteries, and propane tanks over 20 lbs. The homeowner/renter is required to dispose of Hazardous Waste at Onondaga-Herkimer Solid Waste Authority drop-off in Utica, www.ohswna.org/recycle
